Let no one despise your youth, but set the believers an example in speech and conduct, in love, in faith, in purity. Till I come, attend to the public reading of scripture, to preaching, to teaching. Do not neglect the gift you have, which was given you by prophetic utterance when the council of elders laid their hands upon you. Practice these duties, devote yourself to them, so that all may see your progress.

Τῷ καιρῷ ἐκείνῳ, διήρχετο ὁ Ἰησοῦς τὴν Ἱεριχώ· καὶ ἰδοὺ ἀνὴρ ὀνόματι καλούμενος Ζακχαῖος, καὶ αὐτὸς ἦν ἀρχιτελώνης, καὶ οὗτος ἦν πλούσιος, καὶ ἐζήτηε ἰδεῖν τὸν Ἰησοῦν τίς ἐστι, καὶ οὐκ ἠδύνατο ἀπὸ τοῦ ὄχλου, ὅτι τῇ ἡλικίᾳ μικρὸς ἦν. καὶ προδραμὼν ἔμπροσθεν ἀνέβη ἐπὶ συκιμορέαν, ἵνα ἴδῃ αὐτόν, ὅτι δι' ἐκείνης ἡμελλε διέρχεσθαι. καὶ ὡς ἦλθεν ἐπὶ τὸν τόπον, ἀναβλέψας ὁ Ἰησοῦς εἶδεν αὐτόν καὶ εἶπεν πρὸς αὐτόν· Ζακχαῖε, σπεύσας κατὰβηθι· σήμερον γὰρ ἐν τῷ οἴκῳ σου δεῖ με μεῖναι. καὶ σπεύσας κατέβη, καὶ ὑπεδέξατο αὐτόν χαίρων. καὶ ἰδόντες πάντες διεγόγγυζον λέγοντες ὅτι παρὰ ἀμαρτωλῶ ἀνδρὶ εἰσῆλθε καταλῦσαι. σταθεὶς δὲ Ζακχαῖος εἶπε πρὸς τὸν Κύριον· Ἴδου τὰ ἡμίση τῶν ὑπαρχόντων μου, Κύριε, δίδωμι τοῖς πτωχοῖς, καὶ εἴ τινός τι ἐσυκοφάντησα, ἀποδίδωμι τετραπλοῦν. εἶπε δὲ πρὸς αὐτόν ὁ Ἰησοῦς ὅτι σήμερον σωτηρία τῷ οἴκῳ τούτῳ ἐγένετο, καθότι καὶ αὐτὸς υἱὸς Ἀβραάμ ἐστιν· ἦλθε γὰρ ὁ υἱὸς τοῦ ἀνθρώπου ζητῆσαι καὶ σῶσαι τὸ ἀπολωλός.

## THE GOSPEL

Lk. 19:1-10

At that time, Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through. And there was a man named Zacchaeus; he was a chief collector, and rich. And he sought to see who Jesus was, but could not, on account of the crowd, because he was small of stature. So he ran on ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see him, for he was to pass that way. And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste and come down; for I must stay at your house today." So he made haste and came down, and received him joyfully. And when they saw it they all murmured, "He has gone in to be the guest of a man who is a sinner." And Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have defrauded any one of anything, I restore it fourfold." And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, since he also is a son of Abraham. For the Son of man came to seek and to save the lost."

## Timothy the Apostle of the 70

The Holy Apostle Timothy was from the Lycaonian city of Lystra in Asia Minor. Saint Timothy was converted to Christ in the year 52 by the holy Apostle Paul (June 29). When the Apostles Paul and Barnabas first visited the cities of Lycaonia, Saint Paul healed one crippled from birth. Many of the inhabitants of Lystra then believed in Christ, and among them was the future Saint Timothy, his mother Eunice and grandmother Loida (Lois) (Acts 14:6-12; 2 Tim. 1:5).

**The seed of faith, planted in Saint Timothy's soul by the Apostle Paul, brought forth abundant fruit. He became Saint Paul's disciple, and later his constant companion and co-worker in the preaching of the Gospel.** The Apostle Paul loved Saint Timothy and in his Epistles called him his beloved son, remembering his devotion and fidelity with gratitude.

**He wrote to Timothy:** "You have followed my teaching, way of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, love, and patience" (2 Tim. 3:10-11). The Apostle Paul appointed Saint Timothy as Bishop of Ephesus, where the saint remained for fifteen years. Finally, when Saint Paul was in prison and awaiting martyrdom, he summoned his faithful friend, Saint Timothy, for a last farewell (2 Tim. 4:9).

Saint Timothy ended his life as a martyr. The pagans of Ephesus celebrated a festival in honor of their idols, and used to carry them through the city, accompanied by impious ceremonies and songs. Saint Timothy, zealous for the glory of God, attempted to halt the procession and reason with the spiritually blind idol-worshipping people, by preaching the true faith in Christ.

The pagans angrily fell upon the holy apostle, they beat him, dragged him along the ground, and finally, **they stoned him.** Saint Timothy's martyrdom occurred in the year 93.

In the fourth century the holy relics of Saint Timothy were transferred to Constantinople and placed in the church of the Holy Apostles near the tombs of Saint Andrew (November 30) and Saint Luke (October 18). The Church honors Saint Timothy as one of the Apostles of the Seventy.

## Τιμόθεος Απόστολος ἐκ τῶν 70

Ὁ Ἅγιος Απόστολος Τιμόθεος κατήγετο ἐκ Λύστρων τῆς Λυκαονίας. Ὁ πατήρ του, Ἕλληνας εἰδωλολάτρης, κατεῖχεν ἐξέχουσαν κοινωνικὴν θέσιν. Ἡ μήτηρ του Εὐνίκη καὶ ἡ μάμη του Λωΐς ἦσαν Ἰουδαῖαι, ἀσπασθεῖσαι τὸν Χριστιανισμόν. Ὁ Τιμόθεος εἶχε τὴν εὐτυχίαν νὰ γαλουχηθῆ παρ' αὐτῶν εἰς τὰ Εὐαγγελικὰνάματα καὶ νὰ μορφωθῆ χριστιανοπρεπῶς (Β' Τιμ. Α', 5· Γ' 15). Νεώτατος τὴν ἡλικίαν ἦτο ἤδη γνωστὸς εἰς ὅλους τοὺς χριστιανούς τῶν Λύστρων καὶ τοῦ Ἰκονίου διὰ τὴν εὐσέβειαν καὶ τὸν ζῆλον του. (Πράξ. ΙΣΤ', 1-2).

Ὅτε ἦλθεν ὁ Παῦλος εἰς Λύστρα κατὰ τὴν πρώτην ἀποστολικὴν ὁδοπορίαν του μετὰ τοῦ Βαρνάβα, ἐγνωρίσθη μετὰ τοῦ νεαροῦ Τιμοθέου, ἐφιλοξενήθη εἰς τὸν οἶκόν του καὶ προσεῖλκεν αὐτὸν εἰς τὸν Χριστιανισμόν. Ἐπειδὴ ὁ Τιμόθεος ἦτο Ἑλληνικῆς καταγωγῆς, ὑπεβλήθη ὑπὸ τοῦ Παύλου εἰς περιτομήν, ἵνα μὴ δοθῆ λαβὴ εἰς τοὺς ἐν τῇ πόλει Ἰουδαῖζοντας χριστιανούς νὰ διαβάλουν τὴν ἀποστολικότητά του καὶ τὴν γνησιότητα τοῦ Εὐαγγελίου του. Ὁ Τιμόθεος δὲν ἤργησε νὰ συνδεθῆ μετὰ τοῦ Παύλου, τὸν ὁποῖον ἠκολούθησεν ἔπειτα εἰς τὰς ἀποστολικὰς ὁδοπορίας του «καθὰπερ ἄστηρ ἡλίω», γενόμενος «σύσκηνος αὐτῷ καὶ τὸ πᾶν ὁμοδίαιτος». Συμμεριζόμενος τὰς κακουχίας καὶ τὰς ταλαιπωρίας τοῦ ἀποστολικοῦ ἔργου τοῦ Παύλου καὶ συγκακοπαθῶν ὡς καλὸς στρατιώτης Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ, ἀνεδειχθῆ ἀντάξιον τοῦ πνευματικοῦ του πατρὸς, ὁ ὁποῖος μετὰ πολλῆς στοργῆς προνοεῖ περὶ τῆς σοβαρῶς κλονισθείσης ὑγείας του. Βραδύτερον ἐχειροτονήθη ὑπὸ τοῦ Παύλου διάκονος. Κατὰ τὴν τρίτην ὁδοπορίαν ὁ Τιμόθεος ἦλθε μετὰ τοῦ Παύλου εἰς Ἔφεσον, ὅπουθεν ἀπεστάλη μετὰ τοῦ Ἐράστου εἰς Μακεδονίαν. Ἐκεῖ συνηγήθη μετὰ τοῦ Παύλου, τὸν ὁποῖον συνάδεδουσεν εἰς Κόρινθον, Τρωάδα καὶ Ἱερουσόλυμα, εἶτα δὲ εἰς Ῥώμην, ὅπου ἔλαβον χώραν τὰ πρῶτα δεσμὰ τοῦ Παύλου. Μετ' αὐτοῦ πιθανώτατα ἐφυλακίσθη καὶ ὁ Τιμόθεος, ἀπελευθερωθεὶς ἀργότερον (Ἐβρ. ΙΓ', 23). Κατὰ τὴν τετάρτην ὁδοπορίαν ἐχειροτονήθη Ἐπίσκοπος ὑπὸ τοῦ Παύλου εἰς νεαρὰν ἡλικίαν, περὶ τὸ 60 μ.Χ., χρηματίσας πρῶτος Ἐπίσκοπος Ἐφέσου. Ὅλιγον πρὸ τοῦ μαρτυρίου τοῦ Παύλου ἦλθεν ἐκ νέου εἰς Ῥώμην πρὸς συνάντησίν του.

Μετὰ τὸν θάνατον τοῦ Παύλου καὶ τὴν ἄλωσιν τῆς Ἱερουσαλὴμ (70 μ.Χ.) ἦλθεν ἐκ Παλαιστίνης καὶ ἐγκατεστάθη εἰς Ἔφεσον ὁ Εὐαγγελιστὴς Ἰωάννης, ὅπου συνεδέθη μετὰ τοῦ Τιμοθέου, τοῦ ὁποῖου ὑπῆρξε φίλος, διδάσκαλος καὶ συνεργός, παρέμεινε δὲ ἐκεῖ μέχρι τοῦ 96 μ.Χ., ὅτε ἐξωρίσθη εἰς Πάτμον κατὰ τὸν ἐπὶ αὐτοκράτορος Δομετιανοῦ (81-96 μ.Χ.) ἐγεγρῆντα σφοδρὸν κατὰ τῶν χριστιανῶν διωγμὸν.

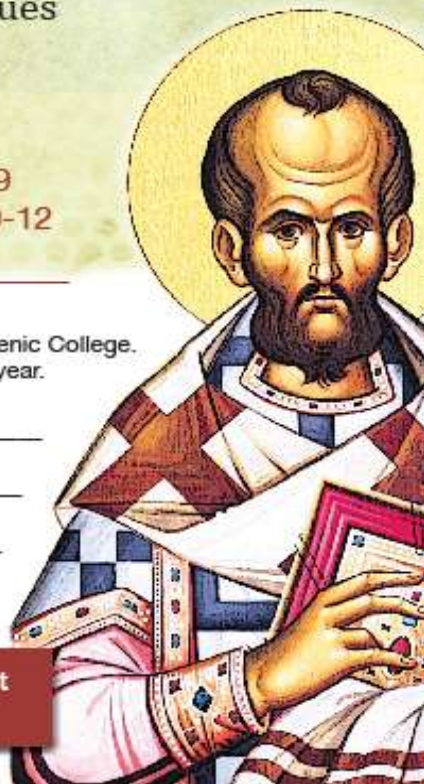
