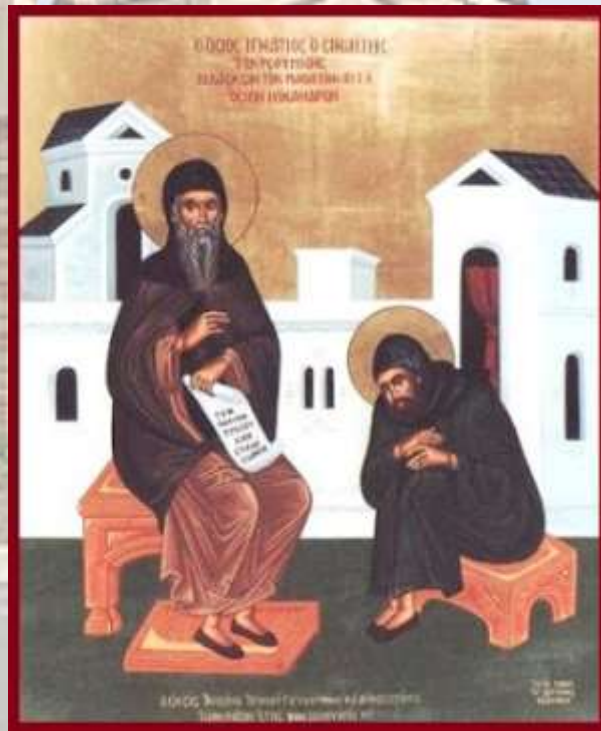

THE GOSPEL

Mt. 15:21-28

At that time, Jesus went to the district of Tyre and Sidon. And behold, a Canaanite woman from that region came out and cried, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David; my daughter is severely possessed by a demon." But he did not answer her a word. And his disciples came and begged him, saying, "Send her away, for she is crying after us." He answered, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." But she came and knelt before him, saying, "Lord, help me." And he answered, "It is not fair to take the children's bread and throw it to the dogs." She said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their master's table." Then Jesus answered her, "O woman, great is your faith! Be it done for you as you desire." And her daughter was healed instantly.

Ignatius and Nicandrus of Sinai

A Sinai Codex of 1716 contains the life and deeds of Saint Nikandros the New Ascetic who shone with virtue and holiness at the Sacred Monastery of Saint Katherine at the holy and God-trodden mountain of Sinai. According to the codex, Saint-Nikandros was born in 1581 on the island of Kastelorizo where there was a metochion of Saint Katherine's Monastery dedicated to the Holy Apostles. He became a monk at Sinai in 1611 and reposed in 1631 in the days of Archbishop Joasaph. While at Sinai there was a very virtuous hieromonk named Ignatios from Rethymno in Crete. Ignatios took Nikandros as his novice. Since both desired to know the monasteries and hermitages of Mount Athos, they went and remained there for five years. But they again returned to the place of their repentance at Sinai believing they could find more quietness there, and there they lived for the rest of their lives.

Hieromonk Ignatios was a very good and virtuous spiritual father. He had perfect indigence and continence and his constant work was prayer. His disciple however, Monk Nikandros, surpassed his Elder. He had greater temperance and indefatigable obedience to his Elder and attained a state of complete dispassion. He never appeared to be joyous or sad but always stood with the same unchanging state of mind. He would do a prostration to everyone and to whatever someone said to him he would always begin by saying "bless father".

Nikandros reposed over a year prior to his spiritual father Ignatios. After a year the fathers went to the cemetery to bury another brother, and when Elder Ignatios entered to see the relics of Nikandros he found the corpse full and having the color of saffron and it was gushing myrrh. Fr. Ignatios left the cemetery with tears, saying: "Thank you, Lord, that even while alive you gave me this information about my novice."

Ἰγνατίος καὶ Νικάνδρος οἱ Σιναίτων

Ἅγιος Ἰγνάτιος

Ἐζησε κατὰ τον 16-17ο αἰώνα, καταγόταν ἀπὸ το Ρέθυμνο της Κρήτης. Πέθανε το 1632. Ἦταν ιερομόναχος και πνευματικός και ο γέροντας του αγίου Νικανδρου. Ἦταν πολὺ ενάρετος, εἶχε ἀκρα ακτημοσύνη και εγκράτεια ἐνὸς προσευχόταν ακατάπαυστα.

Ἅγιος Νικάνδρος

Γεννήθηκε το 1581 και καταγόταν ἀπὸ το Καστελόριζο. Ἐγινε μοναχὸς το 1611 και πέθανε το 1631 ἐπὶ ἀρχιεπισκόπου Σινά Ἰωσήφ. Ἦταν υποτακτικὸς του αγίου Ἰγνατίου. Ἐκανε τέλεια υπακοή στον γέροντα του και συνεχῶς στο στόμα του ἦταν το "εὐλόγησον πάτερ". Ο Νικανδρος κοιμήθηκε πριν τον γέροντα του και ἕνα χρόνο ἀφότου εἶχε κοιμηθεῖ καθὼς ἀνοίγαν το κοιμητήριο ὥστε να βάλουν ἄλλον ἀδελφὸ ο γέροντας του αγίου Νικανδρου πῆγε να δει το λείψανο του υποτακτικὸς του και το βρήκε ἀφθορο και να αναβλύζει μύρο. Τότε ο ἅγιος Ἰγνάτιος ἀγκάλιασε το λείψανο και βγήκε ἐξω με χαμόγελο στα χεῖλη και με δάκρυα στα μάτια λέγοντας σε ευχαριστῶ Κύριε ὅτι με πληροφόρησες για την αγιότητα του υποτακτικὸς μου ἐνὸς ἡμουν ἀκόμη ζωντανός. Ἐζησε δε ο γέροντας 40 ἡμέρες ἀφότου εἶδε το λείψανο και μετὰ κοιμήθηκε και ο ἴδιος.

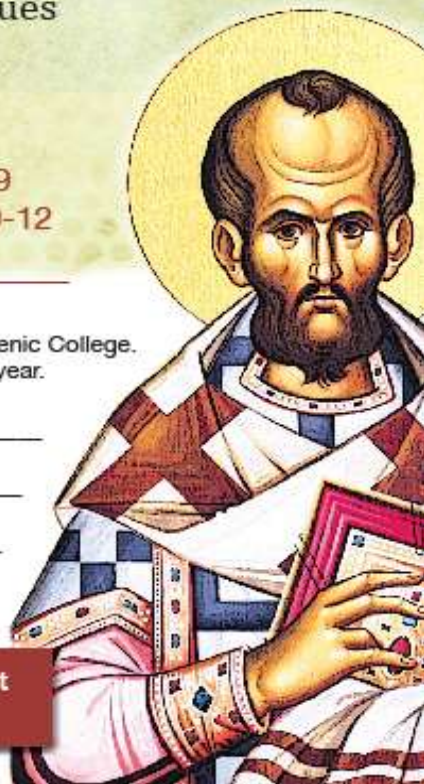
