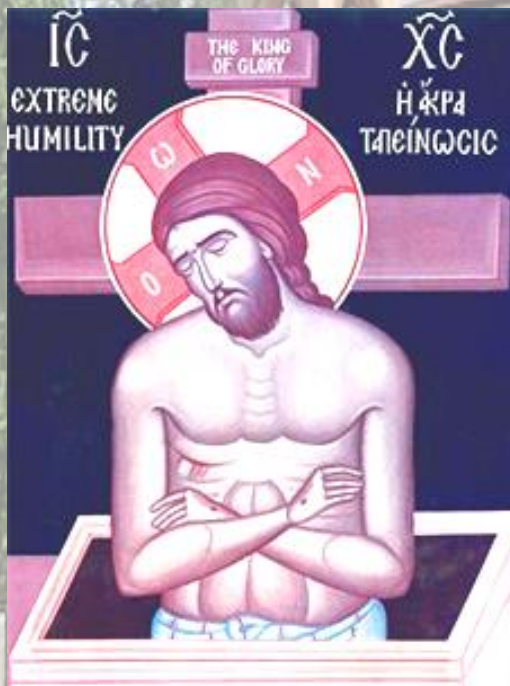

you are the same, and your years
will never end.” But to what angel
has he ever said, “Sit at my right

not all ministering spirits sent forth
to serve, for the sake of those who
are to obtain salvation? Therefore
we must pay closer attention to
what we have heard, lest we drift
away from it. For if the message
declared by angels was valid and
every transgression or disobedience
received a just retribution, how
shall we escape if we neglect such a
great salvation? It was declared at
first by the Lord, and it was attested
to us by those who heard him.

THE GOSPEL

Mk. 2:1 – 12

At that time, Jesus entered Capernaum and it was reported that he was at home. And many were gathered together, so that there was no longer room for them, not even about the door; and he was preaching the word to them. And they came, bringing to him a paralytic carried by four men. And when they could not get near him because of the crowd, they removed the roof above him; and when they had made an opening, they let down the pallet on which the paralytic lay. And when Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, “My son, your sins are forgiven.” Now some of the scribes were sitting there, questioning in their hearts, “Why does this man speak thus? It is a blasphemy! Who can forgive sins but God alone?” And immediately Jesus, perceiving in his spirit that they thus questioned within themselves, said to them, “Why do you question thus in your hearts? Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, ‘Your sins are forgiven,’ or to say, ‘Rise, take up your pallet and walk? But that you may know that the Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins’ — he said to the paralytic — “I say to you, rise, take up your pallet and go home.” And he rose, and immediately took up the pallet and went out before them all; so that they were all amazed and glorified God, saying, “We never saw anything like this!”

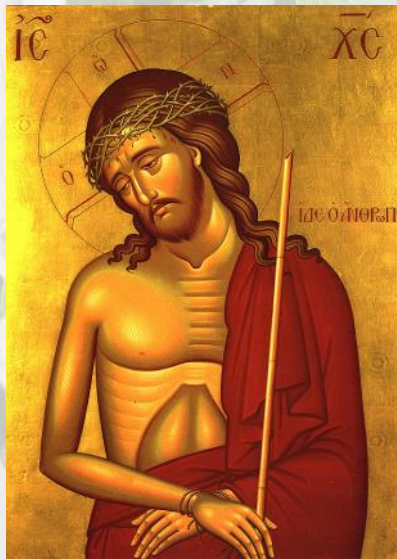

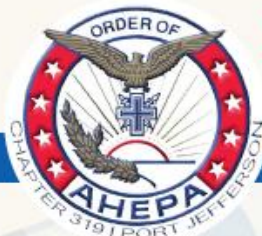

AHEPA Chapter 319 of Port Jefferson is pleased to sponsor SBU's Center for Hellenic Studies' 4th annual essay competition, which focuses on documenting the experiences and history of people of Greek and Cypriot descent who immigrated to the US in the first half of the twentieth century, and who settled on Long Island, NY.
