For the Hieromartyr

Becoming a partner with the Apostles in way of life and successor to their thrones, O God-inspired Saint, in the active life you found an entrance to contemplation. Hence you rightly expounded the word of truth, and you shed your blood in struggling for the faith, O Hieromartyr Cyprian. Intercede with Christ our God, beseeching Him to save our souls.

Keep Thy servant in remembrance, O Lord, since Thou art good; and do Thou forgive every sin in this life; for no man is without sin, except for Thee Who art able to grant rest even unto those who have departed hence.

Apolytikion of the Parish

THE EPISTLE

2 Cor. 6:1-10

Brethren, working together with him, then, we entreat you not to accept the grace of God in vain. For he says, "At the acceptable time I have listened to you, and helped you on the day of salvation." Behold, now is the acceptable time; behold, now is the day of salvation. We put no obstacle in any one's way, so that no fault may be found with our ministry, but as servants of God we commend ourselves in every way: through great endurance, in afflictions, hardships, calamities, beatings, imprisonments, tumults, labors, watching, hunger; by purity, knowledge, forbearance, kindness, the Holy Spirit, genuine love, truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left; in honor and dishonor, in ill repute and good repute. We are treated as impostors, and yet are true; as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and behold we live; as punished, and yet not killed; as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing everything.

Λου ζ' 31 - 36

Γίνεσθε οὖν οἰκτίρμονες καθὼς καὶ ὁ πατὴρ ὑμῶν οἰκτίρμων ἐστίν.

THE GOSPEL

Lk. 6:31-36

The Lord said, "And as you wish that men would do to you, do so to them. If you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. And if you lend to those from whom you hope to receive, what credit is that to you? Even sinners lend to sinners, to receive as much again. But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High; for he is kind to the ungrateful and the selfish. Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful."

Cyprian the Holy Martyr,
Justina the Virgin-martyr of Nicomedeia

Saint Justina who was from Damascus, lived in virginity for the sake of Christ. Saint Cyprian, who was from Antioch, began as an initiate of magic and worshipper of the demons. A certain foolish young man who had been smitten with Justina's beauty hired Cyprian to draw her to love him; when Cyprian had wed every demonic device he knew, and had failed, being repulsed by the power of Christ Whom Justina invoked, he understood the weakness of the demons and came to know the truth. Delivered from demonic delusion, he came to Christ and burned all his books of magic, was baptized, and later ascended the episcopal throne in his country. Later, he and Justina were arrested by the Count of Damascus, and having endured many torments at his hands, they were sent finally to Diocletian in Nicomedia, where they were beheaded about the year 304.

Apolytikion of Martyrs Cyprian and Justina
As a sharer of the ways and a successor to the throne of the Apostles, O inspired of God, thou foundest discipline to be a means of ascent to divine vision. Wherefore, having rightly divided the word of truth, thou didst also contest for the Faith even unto blood, O Hieromartyr Cyprian. Intercede with Christ our God that our souls be saved.

Kontakion of Martyrs Cyprian and Justina
When thou, O godly-minded one, hadst been converted from magic art to knowledge of God, thou becamest a most skilful healer for the whole world, O wise Cyprian, granting cures to them that honour thee with Justina; with her, pray the man-befriending Master to save us, thy servants who sing thy praise.

Ἱερομάρτυρος Κυπριανοῦ καὶ τῆς Ἁγίας
Μάρτυρος Ἰουστίνης τῆς Παρθένου

Ἦταν εὐγενῆς πλούσιος καὶ φιλόσοφος ἀπὸ τὴν Καρχηδόνα τῆς Λιβύης, στὰ χρόνια τοῦ αὐτοκράτορα Δεκίου. Στὴν Ἀντιόχεια, ἐξασκοῦσε ἄριστα τὴν μαγικὴ τέχνη. Κάποτε ὅμως, ἕνας εἰδωλολάτρης, ὁ Ἀγλαΐδας ἐρωτεύθηκε μία παρθένο κόρη, τὴν Ἰουῖσα. Ἀλλὰ ἐπειδὴ ἡ χριστιανὴ κόρη δὲν ἀνταποκρινόταν στὶς ἀμαρτωλές του προτάσεις, αὐτὸς κατέφυγε στὸ μάγο Κυπριανό.

Μπροστὰ στὴ χριστιανικὴ σταθερότητα τῆς Ἰουῖσας, «μαγικῆς ἐμπαιγμάτα κατέκειτο τέχνης, καὶ τῆς ἐπὶ φρονήσει ἀλαζονείας ἔλεγχος ἐφύβριστος». Οἱ ἀπάτες, δηλαδή, τῆς μαγικῆς τέχνης τοῦ μάγου εἶχαν πέσει κάτω, ἀνίκανες νὰ κάνουν καιὸ στὴ χριστιανὴ κόρη. Καὶ ἡ ἀλαζονεία τοῦ Κυπριανοῦ γιὰ τὴν μαγικὴ του σοφία ἀποδειχθηκε γελοία. Τότε, μπροστὰ στὸν ἐπίσκοπο Ἄνθιμο, ἔκαψε τὰ μαγικά του βιβλία καὶ βαπτίσθηκε χριστιανός. Κατόπιν, ἔγινε ἱερέας καὶ ἀργότερα ἐπίσκοπος Καρχηδόνας. Τῆ δὲ Ἰουῖσα χειροτόνησε διακόνισσα καὶ τὴν μετονόμασε σὲ Ἰουστίνη. Στὴ διακονία τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, ὁ Κυπριανὸς ἔδειξε μεγάλο ἀποστολικὸ ζῆλο καὶ γι' αὐτὸ ἐξορίστηκε ἀπὸ τὸ Δέκιο, μαζί μὲ τὴν Ἰουστίνη, στὴ Νικομήδεια. Ἐκεῖ ὁ ἠγεμόνας Κλαύδιος ἀποκεφάλισε τὸν Κυπριανὸ καὶ τὴν Ἰουστίνη. Τὰ τίμα λειψανά τους οἱ χριστιανοὶ τὰ μετέφεραν στὴ Ῥώμη καὶ τὰ ἔθαψαν μὲ τιμές στὸν ἐπισημότερο λόφο τῆς πόλης. Ὁ δὲ Μιχαὴλ Ἰ. Γαλανός, στὸ ἔργο του «Οἱ Βίοι τῶν Ἁγίων» ἔχει διαφοροποιημένο τὸν βίο τοῦ Ἁγίου Κυπριανοῦ, καὶ θεωρεῖ ἱστορικὲς ἀνακριβείες ὅλα τὰ περὶ μαγείας, ποὺ ἀναφέρονται γιὰ τὸ πρόσωπο τοῦ συγκεκριμένου Ἁγίου.

Ἀπολυτίκιον

Θεῖας πίστεως, τῆ φωταυγείᾳ, σκότος ἔλιπες, τῆς ἀσεβείας, καὶ φωστῆρ τῆς ἀληθείας γεγένησαι ποιμαντικῶς γὰρ φαιδρύνας τὸν βίον σου, Κυπριανέ τῆ ἀολήσει δεδόξασαι. Πάτερ Ὅσιε, τὸν Κτίστην ἡμῶν ἰλέωσαι, ὁμοῦ σὺν Ἰουστίνῃ τῇ Θεόφρονι.
