## PASTORAL MESSAGE - Rev. Economos Louis Nicholas, Proestamenos

My Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we approach Great Lent, it is time to prepare ourselves for the journey that lies ahead and to begin contemplating our destination, the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Once we enter into the this most solemn of seasons in the Orthodox Church, we should make every effort to focus more on matters of the spirit and less on the desires of the world, no matter the degree to which we currently are practicing. As we begin to play closer attention to what goes into our mouth, as well as what comes out, the Church also calls us to increase our prayer life and almsgiving.

With that said, I am suggesting to each of you to add something to your daily prayer routine. If you do not pray at all, please begin, and if you do pray daily, please add one more prayer to your daily prayer life. I ask that you say the Lenten Prayer of St. Ephraim each night before you prepare for sleep.

O Lord and Master of my life, give me not the spirit of sloth, meddling, lust for power and idle talk. But grant unto me, Thy servant, a spirit of chastity (integrity), humility, patience and love. Yea, O Lord and King, grant me to see mine own faults and not to judge my brother. For blessed art Thou unto the ages of ages. Amen.






# **Inter GOYA Ski Trip 2023**
