PASTORAL MESSAGE - Rev. Economos Louis Nicholas, Proestamenos

Today is the prelude of God's good pleasure, and the proclamation of humanity's salvation. In the temple of God, the Virgin is presented openly, and in herself she announces Christ to all. Let us, then, with a great voice cry aloud to her: "Rejoice, you are the fulfillment of the Creator's dispensation." - Apolytikion of the Feast

Greetings,

I pray you are well. As we exit the sunny days of the Summer season, we enter into the breathtaking views of Autumn, and as we get closer to the holiday season, we experience another entrance— the entrance of the Theotokos into the Temple.

This entrance is a precursor to the entrance of Christ into the world. As reflected in the Church services for the feast, the Panaghia is the bridge that connects the Old Testament with the New Testament. The main theme of the feast of Mary's entrance to the Temple, repeated many times in the liturgical services, is the fact that she enters the Temple to become, herself, the living temple of God, thus inaugurating the New Testament in which are fulfilled the prophecies of old that "the dwelling of God is with man" and that the human person is the sole proper dwelling place of the Divine Presence.

Today is the preview of the good will of God, of the preaching of the salvation of mankind. The Virgin appears in the temple of God, in anticipation proclaiming Christ to all. Let us rejoice and sing to her: Rejoice, O Divine Fulfillment of the Creator's dispensa-

tion (Troparion).

Once again on this feast, the Old Testament readings are interpreted as symbols of the Mother of God. This "glory of the Lord" is referred to the Mother of Christ and it "fills" her and all people after her who "hear the word of God and keep it" as the Gospel of the festal liturgy proclaims.

Thus, the feast of the Entrance of the Theotokos into the Temple is the feast which celebrates the end of the physical temple in Jerusalem as the dwelling place of God. When the child Mary enters the temple, the time of the temple comes to an end and the "preview of the goodwill of God" is shown forth. On this feast we celebrate—in the person of Christ's mother—that we too are the house and tabernacle of the Lord.

"... We are the temple of the living God, as God said, 'I will live in them and move among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people," (2 Cor 6.16; Is 52.11).

May the Panaghia be with you all.

DISTRICT CHOIR

Hotel reservations are in place and area rehearsals are underway for the historic District Church Musicians Conference and Liturgy taking place November 3rd, 4th and 5th this year. Archbishop Elpidoforos is scheduled to preside over the Divine Liturgy assisted by Fr. George Kazoulis . Hillary Baboukis will be guest conducting the liturgy written by Dawn Helene. Ms. Helene is the current Artist in Residence at the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity, New York, NY. The host parish is the Greek Orthodox Church of the Panagia, on Newport Road, Island Park.

At the conference, business meetings will be held Friday evening where we expect that President, Costas Tsourakis, Vice President, Michael Cofield, Secretary, Fay Pavlidis, Youth Liaison, Alyson Spina, Chanter Liaison, Eleftherios Chasanidis, Webmaster, Joanna Bogardus, and Area Representative, Barbara Karis Downey will be re-elected. Peggy Stilianos is on the slate to replace Dawn Helene as Treasurer. Ms. Helene has been appointed by His Eminence to coordinate the District wide music component which is being added to the St. John Chrysostom Oratorical competition.

Fr. John Vlahos is slated to be the key note speaker for this Conference speaking on our theme, "Spiritual Food". Dawn Helene will be hosting a workshop, "The Art of Composing and Arranging." Dr. Alex Lingas of Capella Romana fame will be hosting another workshop on, "Performance and Practice of Liturgical Music in the Church."

The Church Music Institute will be led by Fotini Downey Robinson, on the subject of females chanting in the church.

July 14 to 16, I attended the National Forum of Greek Orthodox Church Musicians Annual Conference held at the St. Nicholas Parish. St. Louis, Missouri. One of the first orders of business was that we all went to see the Great Arch which is a state landmark. Back at Church, President Costas, Vice President Michael and I had a very educational time as the conference was held in conjunction with the first ever Liturgical Music Composers Forum. Byzantine music experts were on premises to critique the submissions of over 14 composers. Tone and Mode were topics of great concern and a number of pieces were not approved for presentation in church. While beautiful, they were deemed performance pieces, not suitable for liturgy. After a full day of work, we were treated to a performance of West Side Story at The Muny (which is an outdoor theatre).

Liturgy was hosted by Fr. Michael Arbanas and attended by The Very Reverend Fr. Chryssostomos Gilbert, Archdeacon Vasilios Smith, Fr. Jon Magoulias (in town while on his retirement tour), His Eminence Metropolitan Savas of Pittsburgh, and His Eminence Metropolitan Nathanael of Chicago. The combined choir was conducted by National President Nicholas Chimitris. The luncheon after was a lovely event. AXIOS to the entire parish.



Our Mission

The Sunday School of the Assumption is dedicated toward teaching our children their Orthodox faith, as well as the Orthodox Christian way of life.

Sunday Catechism School accepts children from ages 4 -14. Grades Pre-Kindergarten – 8th Grade

Our students will learn Prayers, Hymns, study Holy Days and Feast Days as well as develop a better understanding of the Divine Liturgy, its meaning and its symbols. Our students will learn compassion, charity by collecting donations for the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese Missions & other philanthropic works.

Sunday Catechism School hours are from _10:00 a.m. — 11:00 a.m.
