

Beloved Brothers and Sisters in Christ,


I write to you on the occasion of the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. "Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and his name shall be called Emmanuel (which means *God with us*)," Isaiah 7:14. The prophet's foretelling of Jesus' birth, which Matthew the Evangelist reminds us about in his Gospel, is a comforting message to us all. Our God, through the Virgin's womb, became one of us so that He could be with us. This is the good news of Christmas, that we are not alone. ### DAD CHOIR FEDERATION

This year's 39th annual Church Music Conference was held at the Cathedral of Saint George, Hartford Connecticut on the first weekend of November, 2024. Over 50 musicians from 12 different parishes were welcomed by the Rev. Dr. George Zugravu and Petros Hatjopoulos, their Choir director. The Divine Liturgy performed had been composed by Dr. Tikey Zes, who at over 90 years old, was listening to the rehearsals on Zoom and emailing changes to the music and the stylings over the weekend. He was also the Keynote Speaker on Saturday, appearing by Zoom to the great delight of all present.

Workshops were presented to all who participated including a Youth Choir directed by Alyson Spina of the Archdiocesan Cathedral of the Holy Trinity, NYC. We heard from a speech pathologist regarding preservation of our voices, the use of AI and technical programs in the writing and production of music and Dr. Zes offered a historical perspective of his writing and the heritage of Byzantine music and the tones and seasonal significance to the liturgy. We are so very happy to be back with you.



### **GOLDEN AGE GROUP**


Welcome Back! Our meetings take place in the Community Center of the Parish.

Our students are taught the Lord's Prayer, the Ten Commandments, and the Creed along with the special Saints day and Holy days, and other prayers and hymns.


Through the course of the year we have various crafts for the holidays for the children to take home. We also make icons of their Saints for the Sunday of Orthodoxy.
